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The Neuro Pioneer Hub is more than just a programme. It's a mission to reimagine Malaysia's workforce by unlocking the talent of neurodivergent individuals—those with autism, ADHD, dyslexia and more—who remain one of the country's most underutilised assets. Organisations like EY, JPMorgan and Microsoft have already shown that neurodiverse teams outperform their peers—delivering ROI, innovation, and reliability.

Globally, 15–20% of people are neurodivergent. **In Malaysia, that equates to over 6 million individuals**. Yet fewer than 2% of disabled adults are in formal employment. With the right support, these individuals can thrive in roles requiring creativity, systems thinking, focus, and innovative problem-solving. We're offering a practical, scalable solution: a 20-week pilot accelerator built specifically for neurodivergent Malaysians. Participants receive targeted coaching, mentoring, and training in two pathways—one leading to employment, the other to entrepreneurship.

Total Funding Raise: RM150,000

The pilot will run from September-February 2026 with up to 15 participants

- 1. **IR4.0 Readiness:** We help close the digital, creative and tech skills gap by enabling hidden talent.
- 2. Inclusive Growth: We empower a workforce often excluded from traditional education and hiring.
- 3. Future Resilience: With an ageing population and rising labour demands, cognitive diversity is no longer optional—it's urgent.
